





"One of the oldest (or the oldest) neighborhoods in Lisbon, it is **stunning** & the **best spot** to grab an authentic souvenir to bring home with you."




Miradouro de Santa Luzia

venue is less frequented by tourists. Visit in the evening and check their schedule for events ranging from world music to jazz performances."


